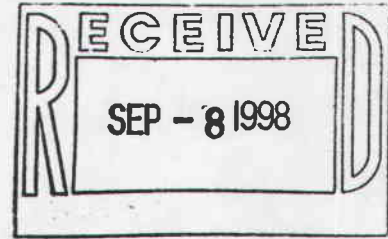

This is in response to your letter concerning possible regulatory requirements for your plans to develop a 240 acre tract of land south of Vivian, Louisiana into an industrial park. The tract is located in section 1, T21N-R16W, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.


Based upon the information provided, we have determined there are jurisdictional areas on the property subject to regulation pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act. The approximate extent of these waters (intermittent streams) within the boundary of the property described in your letter is depicted on the enclosed map (enclosure 1). Any work involving the discharge of dredged or fill material (land clearing, ditching, filling, leveeing, etc.) within the limits of the jurisdictional areas identified will require a Department of the Army Section 404 permit prior to beginning work.

For your convenience, I am enclosing a Department of the Army permit application package with instructions (enclosure 2). Your application for any proposed work in wetlands or other waters of the United States should be submitted at least 90 - 120 days in advance of the proposed starting date. To expedite the evaluation process, please reference the number CEMVK-OD-FS-980008490-TS when submitting the application.

This jurisdictional determination is valid for a period not to exceed 5 years from the date of this letter unless superseded by law, regulation, or policy change.

This is in response to your letter requesting a wetland determination for the subject property located in section 6, T21N-R15W, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.


Based upon the information provided, it appears there are jurisdictional areas on the property subject to regulation pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act. The approximate extent of jurisdictional waters of the United States within the boundary of the property described in your letter is depicted on the enclosed preliminary map (enclosure 1). Any work involving the discharge of dredged or fill material (land clearing, ditching, filling, leveeing, etc.) within the limits of the jurisdictional areas identified will require a Department of the Army Section 404 permit prior to beginning work. Please note that this jurisdictional determination is preliminary and should be used for planning purposes only. A final determination will be made upon your submission of a completed application with project plans. For your information, I have enclosed a copy of an appeals form (enclosure 2).

For your convenience, I am enclosing a Department of the Army permit application package with instructions (enclosure 3). Your application for any proposed work on the subject property should be submitted at least 120 days in advance of the proposed starting date. 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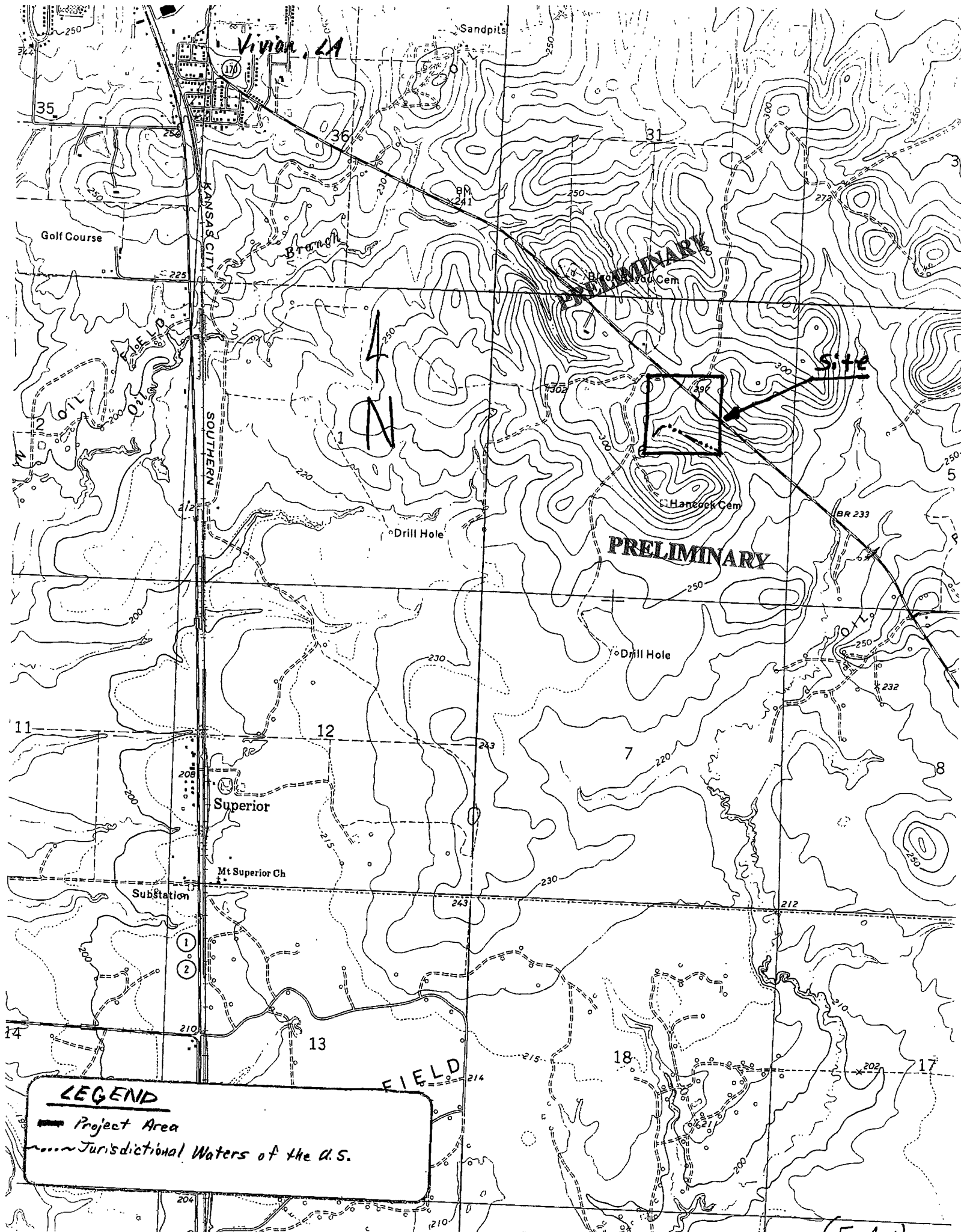
